When?	30th July—5th August
Where?	Brymore Academy, Bridgwater, Somerset
Who is it for?	Anyone presently in school Years 6 to 9
What is it?	A week away filled with activities, fun, silliness and time spent thinking about Jesus.
How much?	Please read all this answer! The total cost is £255. We know this is a large amount and there are bursaries available (and have been used previously. We ask for you to pay £85— if you can afford more, then that would be brilliant as it means we can support more young people. If this is still too much, please do get in touch with Charles—we would love young people to go and can find ways of raising money.
When do I need to pay?	For this year, when you book, you do not need to pay a deposit. A deposit will be needed when booking (usually £30) with the

needed when booking (usually £30) with the rest due 8 weeks before the Venture (so end of May). Again if there are issues here, please speak to Charles.

When do I need to book?	Bookings are open now! We will need to know early in the new yer of those who are interested (and probably have booked by then as well).
How do we get there?	We will work that our nearer the time but we will probably use a minibus or travel together in cars arranged by Holy Trinity. There may be a small added cost if we need to hire a minibus (£5—£10 per person).
What about Covid restrictions?	We ran last summer (2021) under the restrictions as they were. We hope there won't be any restrictions next summer but will run the venture as safely as we can (whatever the circumstances)
Can I be in a group with others I know?	On your booking form, you will be asked who you would like to be in a group with. Put the names on there (as long as they are the same gender!). Generally during the day you will be able to hang out with

anyone.

What if I am unsure?

We are planning on having at least one leader from Holy Trinity who they know on the venture to help young people have a familiar face but do talk to Charles about any anxieties or concerns.
